- √ A copy of the current rabies certificate (if it has been updated recently); and
- √ Please include your email address.

Superintendent's Corner

Update on the Enoch Cobb Early Learning Center and Proposed Playground

The construction on the new Enoch Cobb Early Learning Center is underway and on schedule! A new playground at the early learning center is being proposed with a possible donation from the Barnstable Disability Commission. The Enoch Cobb Early Learning Center Principal Search Committee has begun its search.

As work continues on the Cobb Early Learning Center the following is an update on the project milestones and schedule:

- Site rough grade and drainage work is complete
- Sewer line and manhole installation is complete
- Driveway and parking lot sub-grade is complete
- Footings, foundations and piers poured
- Site backfill is complete
- Unit(s) delivered to Barnstable the week of April 27th
- Building/unit set to begin the week of May 4th
- Building turnover by July 15th

With the construction of the building on schedule, we can turn our focus to finding a Principal to lead the new Enoch Cobb Early Learning Center. The principal search committee is being chaired by the Director of Special Education, Jane Jezard, and committee members include the Assistant Director of Special Education, Eric Bruinooge, and parent Gareth Markwell. The principal search is currently in progress with initial interviews having taken place the week of April 27th. We are excited to find the leader of our youngest learners.

The Barnstable Disability Commission Chair Sheila Mulcahy and member Raye Kaddy have spoken with Tom Lynch and the School Department about donating money for a new playground at the early learning center. The discussion is still in the early stages, but we are looking forward to not only a new early learning center at the opening of the 2015-2016 school year, but a new playground as well.

After years of planning, the Enoch Cobb Early Learning Center is finally going to be opened for the 2015-2016 school year with a new principal and, hopefully, a new playground. I would like to thank everyone who has been involved in the process from the early planning stages to present day.

Cape Cod Healthcare Presents Healthy Aging & Wellness Program

Following the success of the first program, Cape Cod Hospital's Outpatient Rehabilitation Department will offer a second 6-week Senior Health Education & Walking Class beginning **Tuesday**, **May 5th**. Classes will meet on **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays** from **9:30 – 10:30 am** at the **Hyannis Youth & Community Center**, 141 Basset Lane, Hyannis. The cost is \$84 per person for the twelve sessions. Participants must be members of the Hyannis Youth & Community Center. Membership can be easily arranged if needed. Pre- evaluations are required on April 27th. Call 508-771-9600 for more information and to register.

The program will include both physical and educational components. Each class will cover a different topic during a 15 minute class time, followed by a guided warm up, self-paced walk, and guided cool down/stretch. Participant progress will be tracked using the pre and post screenings which will evaluate resting heart rate, blood pressure, weight, posture, body fat %, and balance. Educational topics will include safety/injury prevention, foot wear, vital signs, healthy eating, stress management, benefits of exercise and arthritis, posture/mechanics, common injuries, heart health and exercise for life.

A Note From the Town Collector:

Just a friendly reminder:

√ Fourth Quarter Real Estate and Personal Property Tax bills are due May 1, 2015.

The first commitment of Motor Vehicle Excise Tax bills was issued on February 17, 2015 and was due on March 19, 2015. There are several commitments issued each year for the current year and also for prior years. These bills should be paid timely to avoid interest and penalties. If a bill is issued, it does not go away! You must pay the excise or file for an abatement with the Assessor's office if you no longer own the vehicle and should be done by the due date to avoid interest and penalties.



Town of Barnstable Annual Memorial Day Parade

The Town of Barnstable's Annual Memorial Day Parade will be held on Monday, May 26, 2014.

The parade will form at 9:30 AM at the Centerville Library and kick off sharply at 10:00 AM and proceed down Main Street to Monument Square for a brief program then up Old Stage Road to Beechwood Cemetery. This year's Keynote Speaker 2nd Lieutenant Anamaria D. Gaitan, assigned to the 6th Space Warning Squadron, Cape Cod Air Force Station, Sagamore, MA as a Space Operations Officer Crew Commander.

Following the Memorial Day Parade there will be a Memorial Day Program at the **John F. Kennedy Memorial** at Veterans Park Beach at **12:15 PM** for a brief program to honor our past President.
