III ENFORCEMENT ORDERS

A. Jane Smith – 60 Flume Avenue, Marstons Mills Unpermitted dock/deck on Middle Pond

Ms. Smith and her daughter attended the hearing.

A motion was made to amend the enforcement order to allow the structure to remain during the filing process. The Notice of Intent shall be submitted within sixty days, on or before January 31, 2009.

B. Denise G. Swan – 32 Windswept Way, Osterville

Violation of a Certificate of Compliance "on-going conditions" by cutting several trees on a coastal bank and 50' buffer zone. (cont'd. from 10/21, 11/18).
