Waterways Committee Meeting

May 27, 2014

A meeting of the Town of Barnstable Waterways Committee was held on May, 27 2014 at the Selectmen's Conference Room, 367 Main Street, Hyannis, MA. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Jack Meade.

Call to Order:

New Business:

1. Chairman Meade introduced that the Town Manager would like the Waterways Committee to develop a timeline and plan to address in-season boat storage on Town Property. This plan would define what vessels are allowed at Town Landings and Ways to Water. This topic will be discussed monthly and recommendations will presented to Town Manager once completed.
2. Discuss BSC Group, Inc. plan revision for the proposed pier, ramp and float project located at 153 Freezer Road. Chairman Jack Meade questioned why this topic was back in front of the Waterways Committee after it had been discussed at previous meetings, approved and sent off to the Conservation Commission. Chairman Meade stated "There is a permitted plan already in place why are we revisiting it and whatever the Waterways Committee now determines is irrelevant." The Chairman was uncomfortable giving an opinion one way or another as it would seem the Waterways Committee had a say in the matter, when he believes it didn't. The Chairman went on to say "The Waterways Committee didn't have a clear direction or context why the Conservation Commission asked us to address this issue." Therefore Chairman Meade was unwilling to move on, at that point Mr. Bornstein thanked the Chairman and withdrew from the Waterways Committee.

Old Business: None

Correspondence:

1. Wayne Kurker from Hyannis Marina and Dockside Marine provided historical data for water depths in the Dockside area. He will be asking Conservation Commission to continue maintenance dredging in the Gary Brown ramp area and would like to dredge to an 8 foot depth. No objections from the committee as presented.
2. Mr. Kurker also question the permitted size of the dock and float at the Gary Brown boat ramp. The Harbormaster, DPW, and the Conservation Commission are looking into the permit for the details.
3. Roger Parsons from DPW, updated the Waterways Committee on the completion of the renovation of 3 boat ramps in the town of Barnstable; East Bay, McCarthy's Landing, and Prince Cove Marina. Mr. Parsons stated that \$350,000 in the fiscal year of 2015 will be dedicated to obtaining a comprehensive maintenance dredging permit.

Harbor Master Report:

Marina Manager / Assistant Harbormaster - Eric Shufelt mention that all four Town Marinas are up and running with 7 day week coverage. Blish Point boat ramp has coverage five days a week. Mr. Shufelt also mentioned that the pumpout stations Bismore Marina and Barnstable Harbor Marina are both operational as well as the two pumpout boats.
