2010 New Mooring Permit Information

Mooring permits are issued annually and must be renewed by March 31st of the next year.

The following information is required:

- 1) Completed Mooring Application
- 2) Mooring Inspection (annual)
- 3) Copy of current registration or federal documentation.
- 4) Proof of paid Barnstable Excise Tax (for vessels 17 feet plus)
- 5) Self Addressed stamp envelope (or you can opt to pick up tag and sticker)
- 6) Check made out to the “Town of Barnstable” for \$70.00.

If you are being placed from a waiting list your name will be removed from that list once the permit is issued. Specific locations have been identified for each mooring assigned from the waiting list based upon vessel size and draft. Check with the mooring officer for specific location for mooring placement.

Make sure you obtain a copy of the current mooring regulations; you will need to abide by them. Failure to do so may be grounds to cancel or revoke your mooring permit.

The Harbormasters Office can inspect your mooring if it is brought to the Phinneys Lane office. Otherwise any one of our licensed mooring servicers may inspect the mooring. It is your responsibility to make these arrangements.

You must affix the mooring sticker to the upper transom of your vessel, and the tag to the mooring above the water.
