

**TOWN OF BARNSTABLE
TRANSFER STATION & RECYCLING CENTER
2010 FEE SCHEDULE**

A. DISPOSAL AT RESIDENTIAL TRANSFER STATION

Only Bagged household rubbish, refuse and garbage may be disposed of at the Residential Transfer Station.

***** PROOF OF RESIDENCY AND CAR REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED
TO PURCHASE ALL STICKERS *****

1. Disposal with Solid Waste Stickers: Town residents and residential property owners may purchase Solid Waste Stickers for passenger vehicles, pickups and vans which entitle them to use both the Transfer Station for the disposal of their personal bagged household trash and the Recycling Center. Low income stickers are available. Applications may be picked up at the sticker office.

2. 8 -30 gallon bags per week maximum. See A.3.b for amounts greater than 8- 30 gallon bags per week.

The sticker fees for the 2010 calendar year are as follows:

Purchased January 1, 2010 through August 31, 2010: Sticker valid for all of 2010

First Vehicle	\$130.00
Additional Vehicles*	\$ 15.00
Low- Income	\$ 55.00
Replacement with old sticker	\$ 0.00
Replacement with out old sticker	\$ 20.00

Purchased September 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010: Sticker valid for remainder of 2010

First Vehicle	\$ 60.00
Additional Vehicles*	\$ 5.00
Replacement with old sticker	\$ 0.00
Replacement with out old sticker	\$ 20.00

***All additional vehicles must be registered to the same Barnstable
address as first sticker.**

Stickers must be permanently affixed on inside lower left corner of windshield.

3. Disposal without Solid Waste Sticker

Barnstable residents and property owners making individual trips to the Solid Waste Facility with their own personal bagged trash may use the Transfer Station for the following rates:

- a. Passenger Vehicles per visit delivery – 8 bag limit \$13.00 per entry
There will be a charge of \$1.00 per bag over the 8 bag limit.
- b. Vans, pickup trucks or small utility trailers may dispose up to 8 bags per week maximum. Persons delivering more than 8 bags or those engaged in collecting household trash for property owners and residents other than themselves may deliver bagged household trash to the Solid Waste Facility for disposal. Collectors are not eligible for Transfer Station stickers. All collectors and Transfer Station sticker holding residents with more than 8 bags shall be weighed each time and charged at the rate of \$100.00 per ton.

Note: All vehicles except passenger vehicles must be weighed at the Transfer Station scale, unless the Gate Attendant determines that the minimum charge is in order due to the small volume of trash.

B. CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION (C&D) MATERIALS

Only demolition debris, building trash and bulky items such as furniture, rugs, mattresses, etc. may be disposed of in the designated area. We will not accept rugs larger than 4ft. X 4ft. or lengths of wood longer than 4 feet. Large upholstered furniture, rugs and sofas will be weighed. If sofa is a sleeper then the mattress has to be removed and there will be an additional charge for the mattress. The fee schedule for demolition debris and building trash is as follows:

Passenger Vehicle	\$15.00 minimum charge
All other vehicles (Small Utility Trailer, Large Utility Trailer, Compact & Standard Pickup, Vans and Trucks)	\$160.00 per ton** \$ 30.00 minimum
Mixed loads will be charged a separate rate of	\$300.00 per ton*
Use of Scale for non-solid waste purposes	\$10.00 per use

*Mixed loads are loads that contain 20% (by volume or weight) of metal, cardboard or other ban waste.

**Rates charged may be adjusted up to \$170.00 per ton during the year as market conditions dictate.

Note: All vehicles must be weighed at the landfill scale, unless the Gate Attendant determines that the minimum charge is in order due to the small volume of debris and trash.

C. CHARGE FOR BULKY ITEMS

The charge for bulky items including furniture, mattresses, box springs, rugs, and other items as determined by the Gate Attendant: (NOTE: *** qualifying statements below)

Mattresses and Box Springs	\$15.00 per item
Crib Mattresses	\$ 5.00 per item
Couches, Upholstered furniture and Sliding or Double Doors with Glass	\$20.00 per item
Metal Doors with Glass	\$5.00 per item
Metal Windows with Glass	\$1.00 per item

*** Scrap metal must be clean of all non-metal materials or a disposal charge will be levied - said charge will be calculated as a weight charge or as a bulky item charge, which ever is most appropriate.

*** Any item(s) larger than a 30 gallon trash barrel or weighing more than 20 lbs., singularly or grouped will qualify as bulky items.

D. DISPOSAL AT YARMOUTH TRANSFER STATION

The following schedule covers licensed commercial trash haulers disposing of SEMASS acceptable waste at the Yarmouth Transfer Station, all such material must be weighed at the Yarmouth Transfer Station prior to disposal:

F. TRANSFER STATION SCALES INOPERATIVE

At any time the Transfer Station scale is inoperative, the following schedule shall apply where weighing is required:

Trucks and trailers with rated capacity	\$40.00 per cubic yard
All others (minimum charge in all cases)	\$30.00 per load

G. PACKER SERVICE

H. ENFORCEMENT

It is the responsibility of all users of the Barnstable Transfer Station to stop at the gate and see a gate attendant before disposing of all chargeable items.

Whoever, himself, herself or by his or her agent, or as the agent of any other person or any firm or corporation, violates the above regulations shall be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300).

The driver of any vehicle requiring weighing who leaves the Solid Waste Facility after disposing of trash without having paid the applicable fee shall be subject to criminal prosecution.

Continuous and flagrant disregard for the Rules and Regulations contained herein and/or posted at the Facility shall be deemed sufficient cause for the supervisor of the Solid Waste Facility to bar the entrance of any vehicle, or to revoke a Residential Transfer Station Sticker and issue the owner a pro-rated rebate.

I. EFFECTIVE DATE

Solid Waste Fees in this schedule are intended to be in effect January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 – excepting the commercial per ton fee charged at the Yarmouth Transfer Station. Note: See commercial fees, Section D.

The price of Residential Solid Waste Stickers will remain in effect through the calendar year 2010.

Fees for disposal of individual categories contained herein may be subject to change during the calendar year as solid waste and recycling market conditions change.
