Year in Review 2010 / 2011

The Hyannis Youth & Community Center opened its doors on September 1, 2009 and has been welcoming patrons ever since!

MILESTONES FOR FY '11:

- A logo contest was sponsored by Eastern Bank Charitable Foundation and 65 entries were submitted from as far away as Pennsylvania. The winning entry was selected after more than 694 votes at the HYCC and 16,000+ impressions were logged on-line.
- Business partnerships with the Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce, Hyannis Area Chamber of Commerce, Hyannis Main Street BID, and more have helped to build awareness, offering a spectacular venue for public gatherings.
- 250,000+ visits by people have been made to the Hyannis Youth & Community Center, many individuals over multiple days for a number of different reasons relating to everything from sports and recreational activities to business meetings and social functions.
- 6,000+ hours of ice have been used; about 1/3 were public skating hours.
- 5,000+ hours of gym time have been used; 1/3 was dedicated to high school volleyball and basketball practices and games; free community yoga and open gym time for members. The walking track is open 7am-9pm every day.
- 1,000+ meetings, birthday parties and private functions take place in the various meeting room spaces at the HYCC throughout the year.
- 500+ newspaper articles, blogs, calendar listings and radio interviews have been written about the HYCC and activities that occur at our facility, putting us on the global map and setting the stage for future events and activities.
- 85 businesses are advertising in the facility; 95% are locally owned.



A SAMPLING OF OUR SUCCESS STORIES:

- The Mid-Cape Farmers Market moved from Main Street to our parking lot offering locally grown produce from area farms during the summer and fall.
- A regional high school basketball summer league was developed, including teams from all 11 towns on Cape Cod, offering the best facility for public use on this side of the Canal.
- July – More than 100 vendors from all over the country transformed the Gymnasium and Butler Rink (the ice was covered with our special flooring to create a 17,500 sq. ft trade show floor) during the Antiques on Cape Cod Show, the largest on Cape Cod!
- August – The Bourne Skating Club hosted the US Figure Skating National Showcase Championship with hundreds of skaters from all over the country.



- In September, A Family Fun Day / 1st Birthday Bash Celebration had thousands of citizens throughout the day with a free cookout, Touch-A-Truck, carnival games, a skate park competition and \$1 public skating for all to enjoy. The Cape Cod Cubs opened their season that evening.

- The Inaugural Cape Cod Div. I Collegiate Hockey Classic: Colgate vs. U.S. Military Academy—West Point on Columbus Day Weekend with alumni activities and the first neutral site season opener for both teams!



- Several hockey tournaments including Cape Cod Waves Girls' Hockey Tournament, Barnstable Youth Hockey's new Holiday Invitational, the massive Lobster Pot, Mass. Hockey's "A" Tourney and more kept the ice surfaces, and local businesses busy throughout the winter.
- AAU Basketball tournaments, volleyball clinics and other uses of the Gymnasium included USA Boxing, Boston Hand Ball and a local futsal league.
- Members of the Women's Hockey Olympic gold and silver medal winning teams faced off in front of 1,000+ fans in February when the Canadian Women's Hockey League's Boston Blades played Toronto in a neutral site contest that was the most well attended game in the league.
- The International Theatre on Ice Nations Cup and US Figure Skating National Competition brought more than 60 teams of 20+ skaters each and their colorful props from all over the world in April for a competition.
