Important dates:

- **October 16, 2019** – Last day to register to vote for November 5<sup>th</sup> Town Election. The Office will be open until 8:00 PM.
- **November 4, 2019 NOON** absentee balloting closes. The Clerk's office will **close at noon** to prepare for the Town Election.
- **November 5, 2019** – TOWN ELECTION Polls will be open from 7:00 AM – 8:00 PM.

If you have moved, you need to check in with us to update your voter registration! Please call us to verify your precinct for voting on 508-862-4044.

If you plan to leave for a warmer climate before the November 5<sup>th</sup> Election, please contact the Clerk's office to see if the absentee ballots are available. We hope to have them available by the first week of October.

If you did not receive a Census/Street List form last January, you might want to confirm your voter registration prior to the October 16<sup>th</sup> the last day to register to vote. We can correct your residential and mailing addresses so that you will have no problems at the polls.

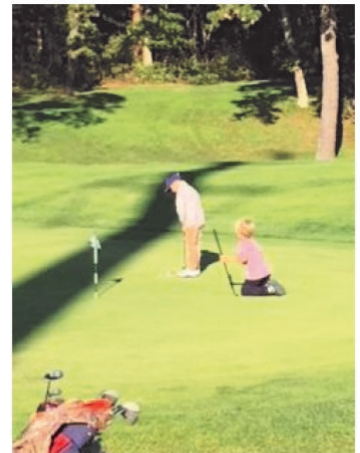

## News You Can Use



**A Message From The Town Treasurer:** It is hard to believe that it has been nearly three months since the consolidation of the Treasurer and Collector offices. Collectively we have made great strides in bringing the Collector's office up to date with billing and payment collection. We appreciate your understanding while we move through this process.

On Tuesday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, Boat Demand Excise bills were mailed for outstanding balances for fiscal years (FY) 2016 thru 2019.

In the very near future we will be sending out Real Estate and Personal Property Demands for FY 2017 thru FY 2019. Outstanding FY 2016 Real Estate will be advertised on October 25<sup>th</sup> for a Tax Taking on November 8, 2019. This is the process in which a lien is placed on the property at the Barnstable County Registry of Deeds. The property cannot be sold or transferred without satisfying the lien.

The Fiscal Year 2020 Preliminary **Real Estate and Personal Property** bills were mailed on June 28, 2019. Please be reminded that the payment for the **First Quarter was due on August 1, 2019** and the **Second Quarter is due November 1, 2019**. The Fiscal Year 2020 Actual Real Estate and Personal Property bills will be mailed by December 31, 2019 with payments due on February 3, 2020 and May 1, 2020.

There are several billings that go out for Motor Vehicle (MV) Excise taxes. The Town receives the information and files from the Registry of Motor Vehicles. Commitment #5 is scheduled to be mailed on October 9<sup>th</sup> with a due date of November 7, 2019. If you have not sold or transferred your vehicle in the past year and have not yet received a bill, please inquire.

### Community Volunteers

Establishing collaborative partnerships to support academic, instructional, and Social Emotional Learning programming is one of the three strategic objectives adopted by the Barnstable School Committee. The Committee formed a Sub-Committee, over a year ago to, to delve into what community partnerships the district and schools have and what is needed. As a result of work within the strategic objective, Barnstable Public Schools (BPS) has established a Family and Community Engagement Center at Hyannis Youth and Community Center (HYCC) to engage with families and the community in school registration facilitation, outreach, support services, advocacy, and volunteerism.

Barnstable Public Schools has launched VIPS – Volunteers in Public Schools – an opportunity for parents, guardians, family members, students, BPS employees, Barnstable town employees, and community members to volunteer in schools. The district's new Family and Community Engagement Center, located at HYCC, is leading the effort in coordination with schools to recruit volunteers.

Every school is looking for volunteers to give their time and special talents to help the district and the children of the Barnstable Public Schools. Volunteer work may include, but is not limited to, school helper, classroom helper, office helper, chaperone, mentor, event planner, or any hobby or talent that would assist the school district in supporting students and the Barnstable Public Schools.

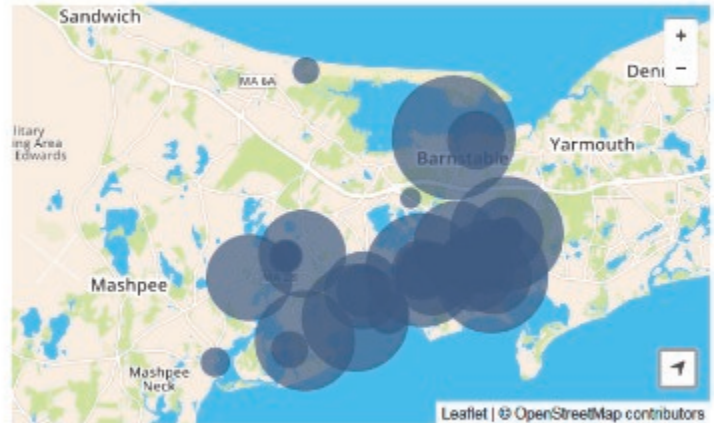

### Centerville-Osterville-Marstons Mills Interconnection Point

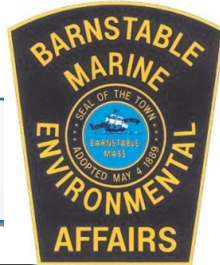
