Councilor Shaughnessy asked about his professional background, as he was placed on the Conservation Commission before she was a Councilor, but stated she had received a letter of support for his reappointment from Mark Akselson.

Mr. Morin stated his experience was gained; he was a lawyer and a realtor.

To The Appointment Committee: As a local property owner I am pleased to be able to write in support of Larry Morin's re-appointment to the Conservation Commission. There are a number of of reasons why I am recommending Larry. Firstly, Larry is a dedicated public servant who takes his responsibilities very seriously. He always puts the public interest first, while remaining accessible to the

property owners who have come before the commission. Larry makes an extra effort to interact with property owners to reconcile the sometimes conflicting positions between their requests, and the environmental issues and responsibilities of the commission. Secondly, from a practical perspective, Larry's experience as an attorney makes him very well qualified to interpret the Environmental Code and the various regulations surrounding conservation issues.

Finally and perhaps most importantly, there are two critical criteria for members of the commission which Larry possesses in abundance: honesty and rigor. Larry does not simply accept things at face value, he will ask questions and investigate until he is satisfied that he has all the facts. It is only at this point that Larry will render a considered, and fair, opinion. These are rare qualities which are all the more necessary in these times, when deep pocketed organizations come before the commission with consultants and arguments which, while seemingly plausible on the surface, are nevertheless contrary to the underlying objective of protecting the environment and local residents. Ultimately, in my experience as a local property owner, I believe Larry is unafraid to "speak the truth to power" and this, in addition to his many other practical qualifications, is why I feel he is a very valuable member of the commission, and should be re-appointed.

Councilor Starr asked about any frustrations he may have encountered while on the Conservation Commission. Mr. Morin stated that every issue that comes before us has issues, but that is what we do as a commission, we try and make it better, some are complex issues and others are simple.

Councilor Atsalis asked Mr. Morin what were some of the more complex issues that he has seen come before the Commission.

Mr. Morin stated that enforcement is an issue, homeowners not complying with the changes made at the Commission level, and the enforcement of those that are not in compliance, or current homeowners that acquired the property.

Councilor Mendes asked about open mind decisions, and if he was able to have an open mind when issues come before the Conservation Commission.

Mr. Morin said that most of the Commission has the material beforehand, so to say that there are not informed opinions prior to a hearing is probably not an accurate statement, however when the applicant is before the Commission, I try and have an open mind and listen to the applicant and their needs and make an informed opinion after that. Compromise is inevitable.
