New Business:

Chair Carey introduced Jake Dewey.

Mr. Dewey spoke about his two current projects.

- 17 High School Rd. between Main and South Streets called the J.P. Baxter House and Residences. An existing building with 2 units and an office space. The lot in the rear will have 4 duplex buildings. It's all by right and is waiting for the Tax Increment Exemption.
- 2. 560 West Main St.- This proposed project will completely rehab the existing abandoned motel into 9 new studio apartments and retain the front, main 3 bedroom house. In addition, there are 4 two bedroom rental units in an apartment building. With the proposed CPC funding support, two of these units will be deed restricted as affordable, serving income eligible tenants.

Mr. Dewey was asked what barriers he thinks about when he starts a project.

- Are there going to be fire sprinklers?
- Water tapping fee is way too high.
- Zoning.
- Wastewater.
- Cost of building.

Ms Cadrin and Chair Carey will meet with the Town Manager to discuss the high cost of water hook-up.

Affordable Housing Trust:

Their goal is to become more active so they have requested that 2.5 million dollars be moved from CPC to AHT so that money can be moved more quickly. CPC has approved and then it has to go to the Town Council. The Committee informally voted unanimously to write a letter of support for this to the Town Council.
