Barnstable Youth Hockey Association Overview - Sean Roycroft, President

The program is going extremely well. He thanked Patti Machado and the rest of the staff for the facility and services provided by the Hyannis Youth and Community Center. He spoke about the great relationship the BYHA has with the South Shore Conference. Patti Machado thanked him for the work with the Bruins Academy, resulting in the little ones being fitted for gear which wouldn't have happened if the BYHA hadn't done this. They have had great success working with the pro shop accepting gently worn gear which is available for free. Also NHLPA donated 30 full sets of gear which helped some get started. All of this was in collaboration with the Barnstable Recreation Division.

BHS Overview - Scott Thomas, AD BHS

The intention of BHS and their coaching staff is to have cohesiveness between BHS and the Recreation Division. They feel there is a need to get everyone unified under one comprehensive program as a means for generating enthusiasm in the younger children for the high school programs.
