Staff Report:

Nina Coleman addressed the Board:

- The ORV sticker renewal applications have been sent out in the mail. Staff is processing them now. The Barnstable Resident stickers are yellow this year and the t-shirts will be yellow, too.
- Gatehouse will open April 1st. Daily hours will be 9 am to 4 pm. (Including weekends).
- Still working on storm damage. Last week's storm was bad but not as bad as the previous storm in early February. Some of the dune "rebuild" is gone staircases are still there just big "step off" because of the sand washing away. It will come back too early to tell when or how much. Again, working on handicapped ramp. Waiting on fencing replacement too soon because of the weather.
- Osprey pole repair tomorrow. Good news only one came down.
- Lot of dead birds razor bills. (20 or 25 found dead).
- Trails 1 & 5 & 6 are passable for cottagers. Trails 2 & 4 are not passable right now. Check the website for information regarding access issues. http://www.town.barnstable.ma.us/SandyNeckPark.

Old Business:

Marsh Trail Repair

Nina Coleman reported the work is starting tomorrow. They could not start before this because of the storm/weather conditions, etc. They need to work around weather and tides. The work will start at Trail 5 and work westward.

New Business:

Air Compressor

Nina Coleman reported that a professional came out and looked at the air compressor. He said there could not have additional hoses. It would be an overheating issue in the shack. There are currently two air compressors in the shack and it would be too hot for both to be running at the same time. She is recommending purchasing a gasoline air compressor (rather than rent on busy weekends). This additional compressor would be portable and used on very busy weekends as a back—up. It can be moved to another location if there is a better spot.

Public Comment:


• Karen Smith addressed the Board and said the area around the air compressor is "cuckoo" over the weekends. She asked if staff could be there on weekends.
