1. Remondi, John J & Dorothy A, 150 East Bay Road, Osterville, MA 02655, map#140/Lot#166; applicant is proposing to construct a set of stairs, boardwalk with kayak racks and a dinghy dock. **No Objections.**
2. Shneur, Felix, 187 Bay Lane, Centerville, MA 02632 map#186/lot#011; applicant proposed to construct an L shaped pier. **Not needed to be heard was a Chapter 91 License Transfer of a property owner. This was incorrectly listed as an NOI the pier already exist.**

Ted Komenda asked about the Number 11 light in Hyannis Inner harbor that has been broken. Harbormaster staff communicated the Coast Guard was notified and it was replaced.

Assistant Harbormaster, Brian Taylor discussed the waitlist lottery that will be taking place Friday July 27, 2018 at 10:00 AM. Approximately, 1000 people signed up for the waitlist lottery.
