CFAC recently completed a brief review of tax-exempt properties in the Town of Barnstable. This review was done as a follow-up to a study completed in 2007 where consideration was given to a PILOT program (Payment in Lieu of Taxes). That program was never launched, but we thought you might be interested in seeing some of the data we reviewed. If you decide in the future that the town should look for additional sources of revenue, perhaps this data will help inform your decision as to whether or not to continue with some form of a PILOT program.

The total number of tax-exempt properties is about 1,700. When the list is filtered to remove all government entities, the list is reduced to 286 properties, or 17% of total number of tax-exempt properties.

The complete list of 1,700 properties has a total assessed value of \$1.23B, and the filtered list is assessed at \$320M, or 26% of total assessed value.

We hope you find the information contained within beneficial to your understanding of tax-exempt property in the town, and as always, we are available for further inquiry or study. The town's tax-exempt property portfolio consists of 1,701 parcels totaling over \$1.23 billion in assessed value. The properties are coded using groupings established by the State Department of Revenue – Division of Local Services and are categorized as follows:

More than half of the tax-exempt property in town, by parcel count and assessed value, is owned by municipal or county entities. This includes the five fire districts in town. Charitable organizations encompass the second largest category. Land coded as "Commonwealth of Massachusetts – Reimbursable Land" is included in the state's PILOT program for which the town receives an annual payment. This is subject to state appropriation every year as part of its budget cycle and the FY 2018 PILOT from the state is \$106,282.

The top 10 sub-groups comprise 84% of the total tax exempt assessed value.

1) The "Improved Educational" category includes all municipal school facilities. Private and Commonwealth Charter Schools are included in the "Other Educational" category and State Colleges represent 5% of the total tax exempt assessed value.

2) Hospitals are the third largest sub-group, which is primarily the Cape Cod Hospital.

3) The "Vacant Conservation Organizations" are principally comprised of the Barnstable Land Trust and MA Audubon Society.

4) Places of worship encompass 6% of all tax exempt assessed value.

5) The Barnstable Housing Authority's properties are assessed at \$29.2 million; both developed and undeveloped land. Property owned by the Authority is exempt from taxes; however, the authority makes a payment in lieu of taxes equal to 10% of rental income charged less utility expenses annually for all of its properties constructed with HUD funding. State funded family projects make a PILOT equal to \$3 per unit month of available dwelling units. State funded scattered site units make a PILOT equal to ½ of the town's tax rate plus \$100 multiplied by the number of available bedrooms. The payment received by the town in FY 2018 totaled \$32,503.

Another illustration of how tax-exempt property is distributed throughout town is by ownership as follows:

Removing the parcels owned by the town, other government agencies, fire districts and libraries leaves a total of 286 parcels with a collective assessed value of just over \$320 million. The Cape Cod Hospital comprises 39% of the net total. The Roman Catholic Bishop of Fall River is the second largest remaining property owner by assessed value representing 7% of the net total.
