## Background

Barnstable Dog Park is located at 1431 Phinneys Lane, Hyannis. There are three (3) entrances to the dog park. Amenities include a drinking fountains, benches, a route near the park and a parking lot.

## Key Accessibility Issues

## Exterior Access Route

Accessibility issues include cross slope higher that the maximum allowed at the dog park entrance on the north side. Additional issues include cross and run slopes higher than the maximum allowed at the exterior route near the park. In addition, there is a lack of an accessible route to dog waste bags.

## Additional Accessibility Issues

- Parking lot sign installed higher than the maximum allowed.
- Lack of clear floor space at the drinking fountains for seated users.
- Lack of drinking fountain for standing users.


## Order of Magnitude Cost Estimates

- Renovate exterior access routes: $\$ 720$
- Drinking fountains for standing users: $\$ 18,168$


## *Total: \$ 18,888

*Cost for exterior route near the park not included.

## Best Practice and Inclusive Design

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend providing a stone dust stable surface around the dog park with no more than 1:50 (2.00\%) cross slope and 1:20 $(5.00 \%)$ run slope that is at least 48 " wide and in operable working conditions.
