
Hyannis Village Green



ADA Transition Plan

October 2021



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Background

Hyannis Village Green is located at 367 Main Street. The Green has a variety of buildings on its east, south and west sides, as well as Ocean Street to the east, South Street to the south, and Main Street to the north. A walkway with a brick surface, which is also part of the Kennedy Legacy Trail, winds through the Green. Some of the many additional amenities at the Green include benches, a sculpture of Chief Sachem Iyanough, two (2) memorials, artist shanties, a visitor information center and a band shell. The Green is host to numerous community events including movie nights, exercise classes and live music performances.

Note: Access to the bandstand on the east side of the Green, artist shanties at the southeast end of the Green and to adjacent points of interest such as the John F. Kennedy Museum are reviewed in separate narrative reports.

Note: IHCD team was told that members of the public do not enter the visitor information center. Instead, staff and information are made available at the exterior of the structure.

There is an at-grade entry point on Ocean Street at the Green's southeast corner where the walkway leads south through the Green towards the Barnstable Town Hall and the artist shanties. This entry point can also be accessed from some stairs or from an at-grade walkway on South Street. Another at-grade entry point is on Main Street. That entry point, on the Green's north side, is near the aforementioned sculpture and visitor information center.

Key Accessibility Issues

Exterior Accessible Routes

Accessibility issues with exterior routes to and within the Hyannis Village Green include:

- Excessive running and cross slopes.
- Excessive changes in level.

- Walkway section by Town Hall that is narrower than required due to a raised tree route that is also a protruding object in the accessible route.
- A walkway section that does not prevent the accumulation of water.
- Lack of an accessible route to a memorial by the Green (northwest side).

Order of Magnitude Cost Estimates


Renovate exterior accessible routes: \$10.508

Best Practice and Inclusive Design

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend providing a 48" wide min. stable, firm and slipresistant accessible walkway from the existing walkway in Hyannis Village Green along the desire line running across the grass to the Town Hall parking lot.
- Recommend providing a 36" by 48" firm, stable and slipresistant area alongside one bench in each area of the park where benches are provided so that a person using a wheelchair or other mobility device is able to sit alongside someone seated on the bench with her/his shoulders aligned.
