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Background

Year Built – Course: 1961, Pro Shop: 1975, Function Room: 1999

Hyannis Golf Course is located at 1800 lyannough Road. It is a par 71 course with 18 holes. Multiple tees at each whole allow the total course length to be between 5149 and 6621 yards.

In addition to the golf course itself, facilities include a 55-station practice driving range, two practice putting greens, a starter's shed, and a portable toilet on the golf course by Hole #6. A parking lot is located at the northwest end of the facility. It has two-hundred parking spaces including four (4) car and one (1) van accessible parking space.

The parking lot abuts a two-story building with a ground-floor pro shop and a snack bar service window that can be accessed from outside the building. The ground floor also has men's and women's multi-user toilet rooms and shower compartments. The second-floor has a "clubhouse" restaurant that can be accessed by an exterior ramp (northeast side). The restaurant also has a deck with dining tables. The second-floor also has a second function room and multi-user men's and women's toilet rooms. There are no showers on the second level, and there is no elevator or other means of interior accessible vertical access in the building.

Note: The clubhouse room and restaurant area were both under construction on the day of IHCD's visit and therefore could not be fully surveyed.

Note: IHCD team was told that golf carts are available for visitors who have a mobility disability or any disability that would benefit from the use of a golf cart. Customers can call ahead and have a cart brought to them in the parking lot so they do not have to navigate the sloped path form the parking lot to where the golf carts are made available. The cart is equipped with a blue flag displaying the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA), and the cart user is permitted to drive on all paths, on the fairways, up to the teeing boxes and onto the greens.

Key Accessibility Issues

Exterior Routes

Accessibility issues include excessive running slopes, cross slopes and changes in level at walkways around the pro shop and restaurant building, excessive changes in level at the entry to the driving range bays and lack of an accessible route to the portable toilet near Tee #6.

Note: IHCD team was told that the asphalt paths through the golf course that presently are about 6' feet wide will be replaced in eighteen months with paths that are 8' feet wide.

Parking

Accessibility issues include lack of one (1) additional car accessible parking space with a marked access aisle and identification sign with the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) and lack of a designation sign with the International Symbol of Accessibility at one existing car accessible parking space.

Doors

Accessibility issues include doors with thresholds that are higher than the maximum height allowed, door hardware that requires tight grasping, pinching, or twisting of the wrist, doors that require excessive opening force, and doors that lack the minimum required maneuvering clearance.

Toilet Rooms

Accessibility issues at the toilet rooms in the pro shop, club house and restaurant building include doors that are narrower than the minimum width required (men's and women's toilet rooms on the first floor) lack of an accessible compartment with the minimum required turning space, hand dryers that protrude into the circulation path, and lack of an accessible transfer shower at the men's and women's multi-user toilet rooms on the first floor. There is also lack of the minimum required knee and toe clearance at both lavatories on the first floor, the mirror is mounted higher than the maximum height allowed at the

women's first floor lavatory, there is lack of wrapped pipes at the men's first floor lavatory, and the urinals are mounted higher than the maximum height allowed at the men's toilet rooms on both the first and second floors. There is also lack of an accessible portable toilet where a portable toilet is provided near Tee #6.

<u>Signage</u>

Accessibility issues include lack of a directional sign at an inaccessible entrance to the pro shop directing visitors to the closest accessible entrance, lack of an illuminated sign with the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) at the accessible egress from the pro shop, lack of signs including egress signage with raised characters and braille, and lack of or misplaced designation signage.

Assistive Listening System

Accessibility issues include lack of an assistive listening system in the clubhouse dining area.

Note: In assembly areas where audible communication is integral to the use of the space, an assistive listening system shall be provided. Assistive listening systems shall be identified by the International Symbol of Access for Hearing Loss.

Additional Accessibility Issues

- Service counters are higher than the maximum height allowed (snack shop, pro shop, restaurant).
- Clothes racks in the pro shop protrude into the circulation path.
- The clothes rod in the club house dining area closet is higher than the maximum height allowed.

Order of Magnitude Cost Estimates

- Provide and renovate exterior accessible routes: \$3,474
- Provide and renovate accessible parking spaces: \$2,350
- Renovate doors: \$8,450
- Renovate toilet rooms and showers: \$38,398
- Provide an assistive listening system in the club house dining area: \$1,214

- Provide compliant signs (directional, designation and egress): \$1,738
- Miscellaneous corrective actions (accessible service counters, protruding objects, etc.): \$3,508

Total: \$59,132

Best Practice and Inclusive Design

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend, in each area where there are benches, providing a stable, firm and slip resistant surface on one end of at least one bench (such as stone dust or asphalt) that is at least 36" wide and 48" deep so a person in a wheelchair could sit alongside a companion on the bench with their shoulders aligned.
- Recommend providing a wayfinding sign, perhaps with a directional arrow, identifying the correct route to the fifth hole.
- Recommend, although golf carts have an alternative adjacent accessible route, providing a compliant ramp on the route to and from the pro shop and practice greens.
- Recommend providing an adjustable height podium with knee and toe clearance in the clubhouse dining area.
