GATE ATTENDANT JOB DESCRIPTION: This is an outdoor position responsible for positive customer service, collection of revenue at various sites, and checking of parking permits. Sweatshirt and shirts provided as uniform.

POSITION HOURS: Monday - Sunday, 3-5 days a week either 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM or 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM. (Each employee's schedule will differ depending on days off and beach site.). Craigville's Beach hours are 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Must be 16 years of age or older. Must be American Red Cross Adult CPR/AED, Pediatric CPR and First Aid certified.

BEACH AIDE JOB DESCRIPTION: This is an outdoor & indoor position with the primary responsible of keeping the beach facilities clean; other duties include positive customer service and assisting Beach Supervisor. Sweatshirt and shirts provided as uniform.

POSITION HOURS: Monday - Sunday, 3 or 4 days a week, Noon to 5:00 PM. (Each employee's schedule will differ depending on days off and beach site.).

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Must be 14 years of age or older. American Red Cross Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED certification recommended.
