

# Have you ever wanted to learn how to shellfish? Have you been before, but you're still looking for more tips? Here is your chance!

- ★ Natural Resources staff will be available to assist anyone who wants to learn to dig quahogs and steamers or just to get a few more pointers!
- ★ Be prepared to get wet! The shellfish live in wet sand that gets covered by saltwater when the tide is high. Waders, hip boots or knee boots would be helpful. Protective gloves are
- ★ Shellfish may be taken by hand or rake. Small (garden) hand rakes and trowels will be allowed for children only.
- ★ Shellfish that are legally harvested with a valid permit may be taken home. You do not need a shellfish license to participate in the class, but do need one if you wish to take home your catch.
- ★ SHELLFISH REGULATIONS APPLY AS ALWAYS!
