

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This program provides participants the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize, and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide care for cardiac and breathing emergencies, injuries, and sudden illnesses until EMS personnel take over.

PREREQUISITES

Minimum 15 years old by June 11, 2023, swim 500 yards continuous freestyle under 10 minutes, tread water for two minutes using only legs, and surface dive seven to ten feet.

REGISTRATION On-line registration is available beginning at 8:45 AM on the first day of registration Residents/Non Residents - Friday, April 28, 2023. You may log onto our online registration feature at www.townofbarnstable.us/recreation and click on the "On-line Registration" button. You will need a user name and password in order to utilize the online program registration system. If you need assistance, please call our office during business hours of 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. Walk-in registration hours are Monday through Friday, 8:45AM to 4:00PM, at 141 Bassett Lane, Hyannis, MA
