



Craigville Beach will be staffed through Friday, August 29th, but will not have lifeguards for the Labor Day weekend.



STATE OF WATER SUPPLY CONSERVATION

Mandatory restrictions on non-essential outdoor water use:

- Outdoor watering (by hand only) restricted to 2 days or fewer per week
- Outdoor watering via hand-held hose or bucket permitted from 5:00 PM to 9:00 AM
- Washing vehicles is prohibited, except in a commercial car wash or for operator safety
- Washing of exterior surfaces is prohibited, except when applying paint, pavement, etc.
- Filling or refilling of swimming pools, with your onsite water source, is prohibited



Household hazardous waste (HHW) collections protect our local drinking water. Most chemicals are too toxic to throw away in regular trash or dump down the drain, so collections for residents are being held to take that waste off your hands and keep it out of our water supply.

We define Residents as people who own a home, own a second home, are tenants, or landlords in the town. Proof of residency includes one of the following: Drivers License with in-town address or tax bill.

Congrats! MassHCIC's 2024 Summer All-Star Internship Program

The All-Stars Program provides an opportunity for college students and Cape Cod towns/organizations to work together on housing and climate initiatives throughout the region. Students spend a summer with a host family on the Cape to accomplish two main goals. The first, is to develop their own research project at the intersection of affordable housing, environmental sustainability, and/or climate resilience. The second aspect involves each pair of interns to be partnered with a town on the Cape. Through this partnership, interns collect data on municipal assets, pair those with potential climate/housing tech innovators who can pilot test a solution, and complete any other town projects/initiatives related to housing, energy, or climate.

Some interesting projects from this year include:

- An examination of our bike infrastructure with recommendations for expansion and the economic benefits of doing so
- A survey of healthcare workers in Barnstable and what housing challenges they face, along with recommendations




