

Mooring Permit/Mooring Waitlist/Slip Waitlist renewals are due on February 28, 2025

Annual Slip Contract: May 1, 2025 (first 1/2 payment, paperwork & completed contract) June 1, 2025 (final payment)

Late renewal period runs until March 31, 2025, with an additional \$50 late fee. Payments accepted in-person, by mail (must be received in our office by due date for waitlists), online or via our drop box! Our team is happy to assist anyone through the process!

How can you help?

One of the most important things you can do to help our plow drivers is to prepare your home ahead of the storm by marking the edge of your property with reflective stakes.

- Plow stakes can be wood or fiberglass with reflectors on top or wrapped around the body of the stake.
- The reflective material needs to be high enough up the stake that it can be seen over the snow drift.
- Stakes should be driven into the ground as close to the edge of the property as possible.
- Generally, we recommend placing them every 8-10 feet.

FOLLOW PUBLIC SAFETY ADVICE

- When a driving ban is in effect, please stay off the roads. It is for your protection.
- Reduce your speed. This is the number one cause of winter accidents.
- Please give plows and sanders the right of way and stay at least 50 feet back from each.







The Town of Barnstable Tourism Mini-Grant Program is designed to support our seven villages in promoting new or existing events and festivals to draw visitors to our town and villages. All civic associations and nonprofit organizations within the Town of Barnstable that produce and market events to visitors and/or provide visitor services are eligible to apply. Events that promote off-season visitation are encouraged.

Grants are available up to a maximum of \$1,000 per applicant, and require one-to-one matching funds. A total of \$9,000 is available in funding for the grant program, which is funded through a portion of the Town's rooms tax revenues.

Applications must be submitted to the Town of Barnstable on or before 11:59 pm, Sunday, March 2nd, 2025.




