

The Boating Safety Seven

1. Wear your life jacket
2. Take a boating safety class
3. Carry all required safety gear
4. Use your engine cut-off switch
5. File a float plan
6. Be aware of weather and water conditions
7. Boat sober, and be considerate of others



Practice the 3 Cs of Boating Safety

CAUTION, COURTESY, AND COMMON SENSE

- Use CAUTION, especially in close quarter maneuvering situations with other boats. In such situations, slow speeds are better.
- Be COURTEOUS to your fellow boaters
- Use COMMON sense. Don't cut people off at the launch ramp, and never light fireworks from your boat!


