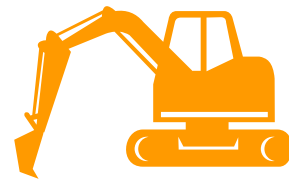

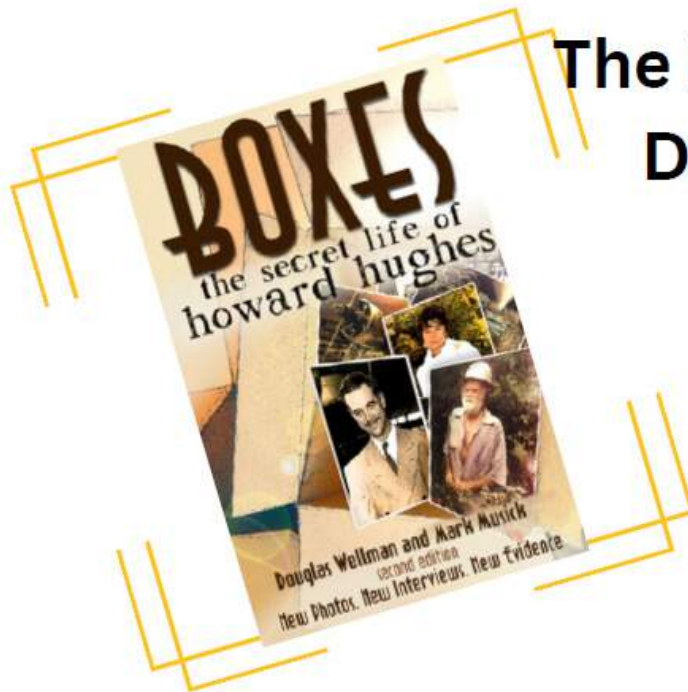

Teaching a person to self-travel can have several benefits. Independent travel can support the individual in broadening their involvement within the community and allow them to make use of more recreational, educational and employment opportunities. Self-Travel can also aid in improving self-esteem, which can encourage an individual to learn new skills and take advantage of more opportunities to function independently and become more self-reliant.
