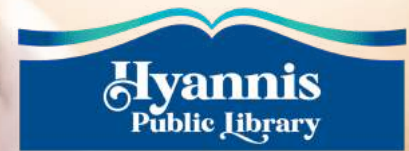

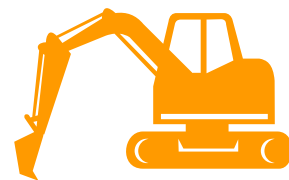

Review Your Application Anytime/Anywhere



Open Gov can be accessed on any smart device. You can log into your account at anytime. You can track the review progress and staff comments live!

When Should I Submit My Application?



You may submit a Special Event application 1 year in advance of the event date. Special Events with less than 1,000 people expected in attendance are required to submit 45 days prior to the event date. Events with more than 1,000 people in attendance are required to submit 90 days prior to to the event date.

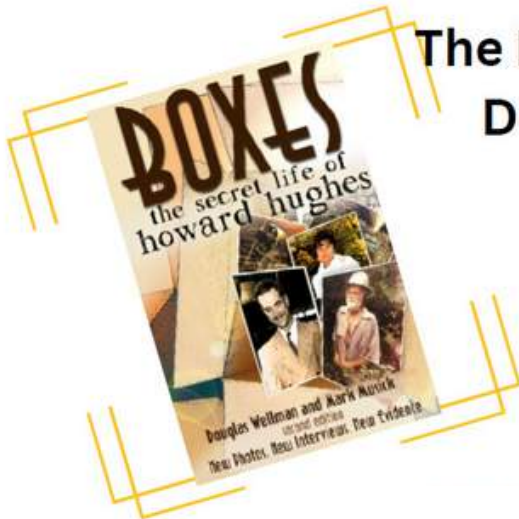

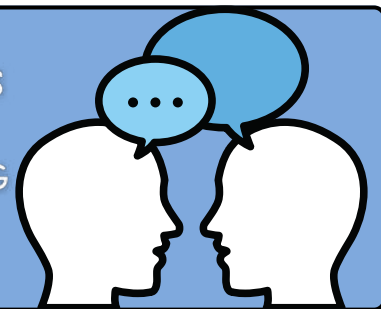

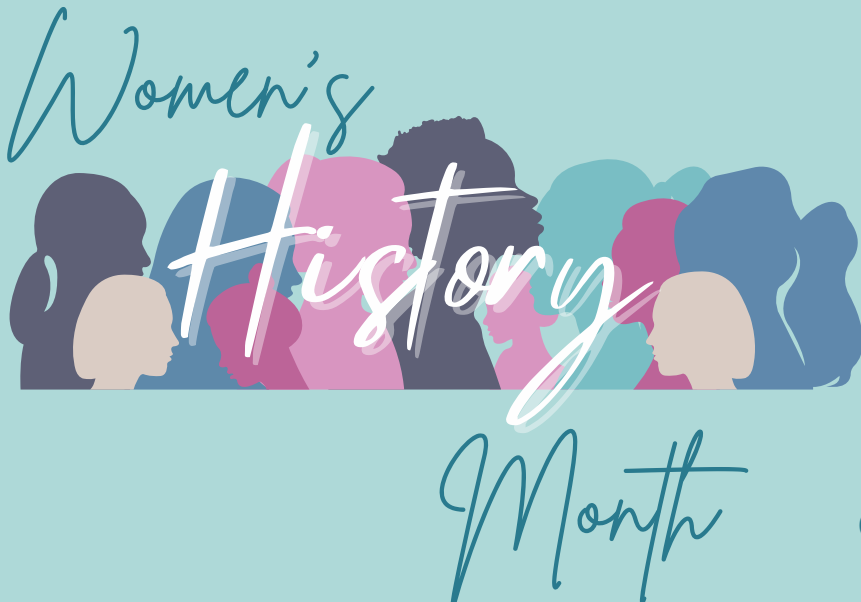
