


OPIOID ABATEMENT FUNDS: NEXT ROUND OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE



In accordance with Massachusetts General Law (MGL) Chapter 87, Shade Trees, all persons deemed interested or affected by the Town of Barnstable's proposed tree removal are hereby notified that a public hearing will be held to discuss the removal of 91 trees. The tree removals are necessary to support Phase 3 of the Cape Cod Rail Trail (CCRT), which will extend the trail from Old Town House Road in Yarmouth to Mary Dunn Road in Barnstable.

This hearing will be held virtually via Zoom on Wednesday, March 19, 2025 at 6:00 PM.



DREDGE NOTICE

The Barnstable County Dredge Cod Fish II will be conducting dredge operations in the Popponesset Approach Channel, located in Nantucket Sound, from March 12, 2025, to March 29, 2025. Dredging will take place in the channel with the dredge pipe running from the Cod Fish II to the discharge locations on the south side of Popponesset spit. The dredge Cod Fish II is stationary and has limited maneuverability. The discharge pipe will be floating at times during dredging operations and may be blocking the channel. There may be cables extending on both the port and starboard side of the forward part of the dredge leading to anchors with floats marking their locations. Mariners are requested to give adequate clearance to the equipment at all times and to contact the dredge on VHF-FM CH 16 and 18 to arrange for passing arrangements when operating.




