






District Improvement Financing Public Information Session March 27, 2024 at 3:00pm

The Town of Barnstable invites the public to a virtual District Improvement Financing (DIF)
Information Session on Wednesday, March 27th at 3:00pm.

<u>District Improvement Financing (DIF)</u> is a local tool that allows a municipality to identify and capture incremental tax revenues from new private investment in a specific area and direct them toward public improvements and economic development projects. DIF is not a new tax or special assessment, and it does not increase a municipality's tax rate.

The Town recently received a grant through MassDevelopment's Real Estate Technical Assistance Program to examine the possible benefits of creating a District Improvement Financing Program for downtown Hyannis. The Town's consultant, Camoin Associates, will provide an overview of the potential program at this public information session.






