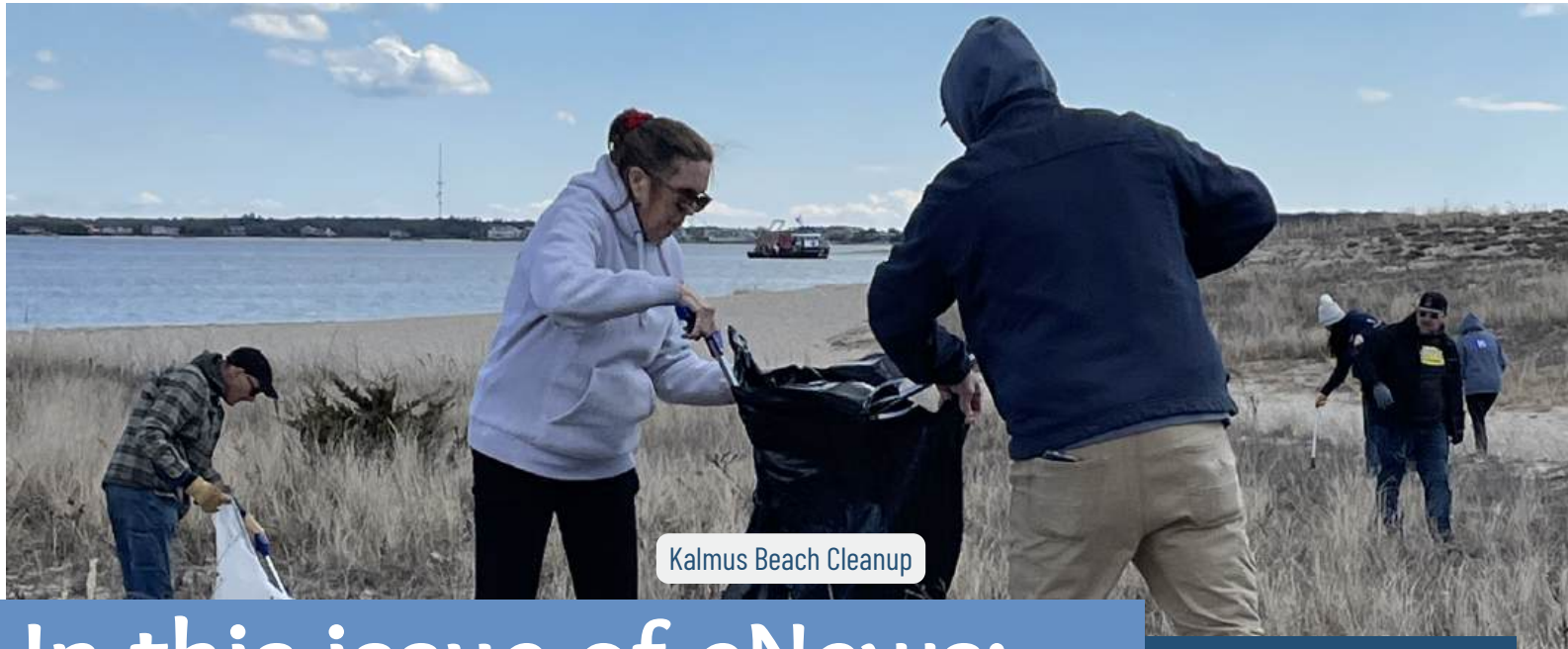

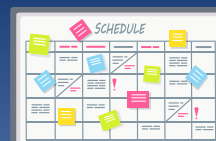

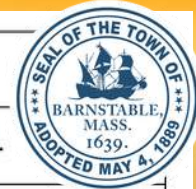
OPIOID ABATEMENT FUNDS: NEXT ROUND OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY

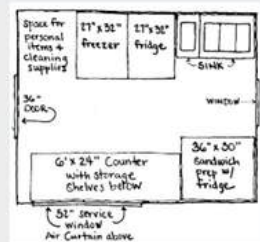

The Regional Policy Plan serves as a blueprint for Cape Cod's future, outlining strategies to direct growth to appropriate locations, protect natural resources, and promote economic resilience. Since the first edition in 1991, the RPP has undergone several updates, including major revisions in 2009 and 2018. The current review offers a chance to assess the impact of the significant changes in the region over the last five years, and ensure the Cape's unique challenges—housing, climate change, infrastructure, water quality and economic sustainability, among others—are effectively addressed and reflected in regional policies and goals.

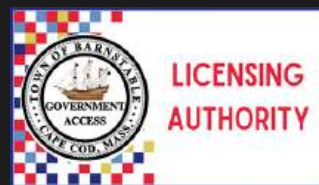

Infrastructure improvement is an inevitable part of life. From paving roads, updating bridges and culverts, adding sidewalks and bike lanes, reconstructing intersections, and improving safety – road work projects help ensure our region's transportation system is safe, up-to-date, and accessible to all users.

Each year, the Cape Cod Metropolitan Planning Organization, with advisement from the Joint Transportation Committee, guidance from Cape Cod Commission transportation staff, and input from the public, helps to create the Transportation Improvement Program and Unified Planning Work Program to guide funding for infrastructure improvement projects on Cape Cod.

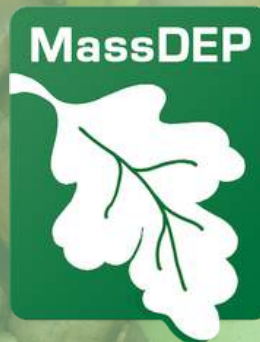

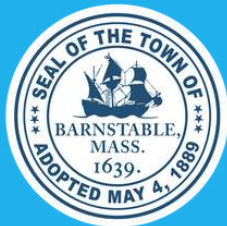

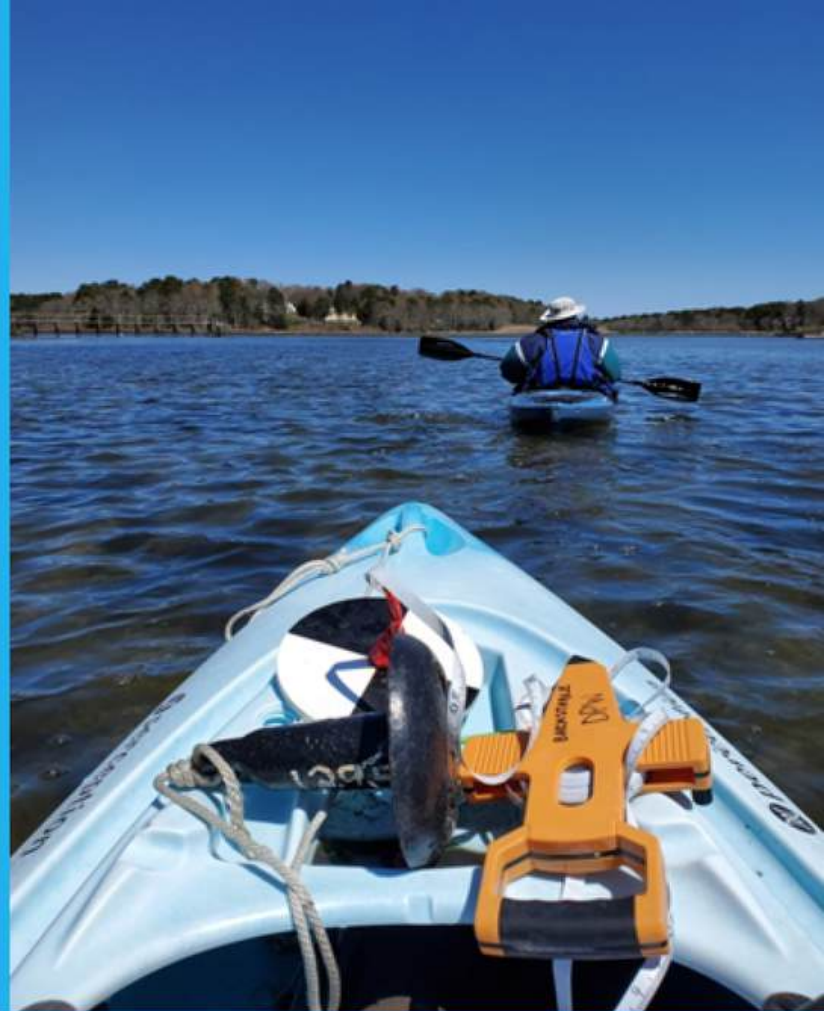
