PAVEMENT REPAIRS AT HYANNIS HARBOR



A small section of the parking lot just south of the Harbor Master's Office located at 180 Ocean Street in Hyannis will be repaired on Tuesday, May 24th.

A 40 ft. by 40 ft. section of the parking lot will be milled and repaved to correct a small drainage issue.

All work is expected to be completed between the hours of 7:00 AM to 12:00 PM.

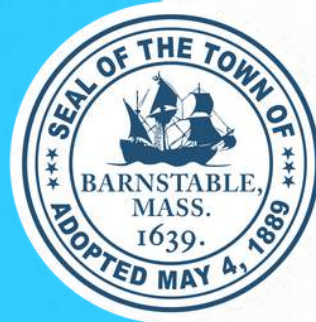
