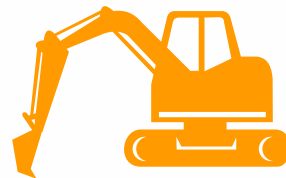

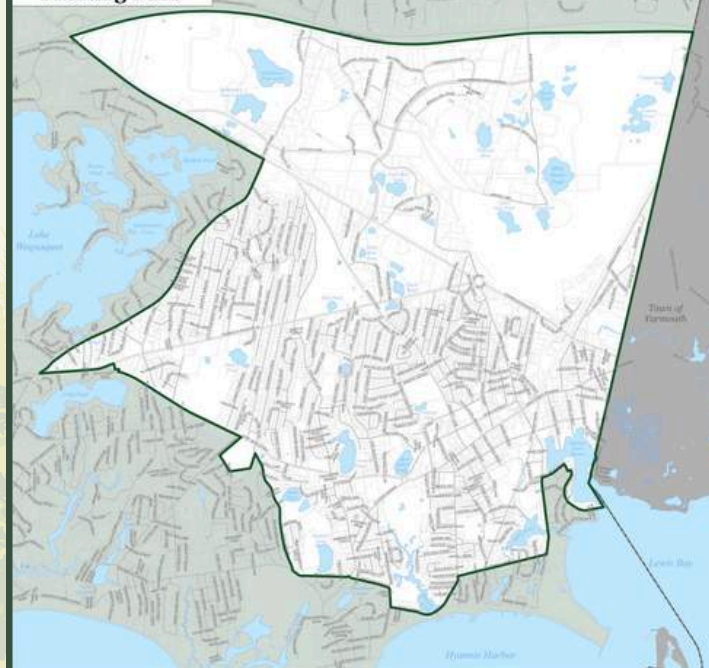

The Town of Barnstable will host a public workshop for the Marstons Mills Former School Site Master Plan on Wednesday, May 29th at 6:00 PM at Liberty Hall, 2150 Main Street, Marstons Mills.

The intent of the public workshop is to continue to garner community input as to the future redevelopment of this site. This is the third public listening session hosted by the Planning and Development Department. The Town of Barnstable is seeking to create a Master Site Development Plan for the 14.2-acre parcel formerly the site of the Marstons Mills Elementary school and public input is critical to successfully establish site-specific land use goals which will inform the Master Plan. Design Public Hearing Route 132 Park and Ride Expansion And Improvements

What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Route 132 Park & Ride Expansion and Improvements project.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of expanding the existing facility by adding 270 vehicle parking spaces, including pick-up/drop off area, accessible parking, electrical vehicle charging stations; replacing the existing bus passenger shelters with new larger ones, accessible pedestrian facilities, and improved lighting.

Friendly Reminder to ALL Barnstable Dog Owners

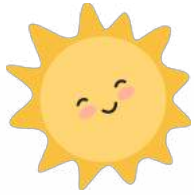
Starting Friday, May 17th dog licenses will be available for purchase online and in-person at the Town Clerk's Department (367 Main Street, Hyannis MA).
