





## TOWN OF BARNSTABLE SENIOR/VETERAN TAX WORK-OFF PROGRAM

The Senior/Veteran Tax Work-Off Program is an opportunity for Veterans and residents over the age of 60 to reduce their real estate tax bill by volunteering with Town Departments. The property tax credit, minus any required withholdings, will be applied to the participant's real estate tax bill. Requirements Include:

Must be 60 years of age or older or a veteran

Reside in Barnstable at the property where tax relief is sought for at least one year

Be the homeowner, spouse of the owner or trustee of the property

Applicants will be matched to a department based on availability, skill set, and interest.

Registration Dates: May 1 - June 30, 2025 | Volunteer Start and End Dates: July 1, 2025 - June 30, 2026

Maximum Number of Participants: 20 each year




