September NOTICE 10th! ORAL RABIES VACCINE DISTRIBUTION

The current vaccination zone will cover the area from the Cape Cod Canal east to Barnstable and south to Falmouth. In addition, mainland Bourne and Sandwich, Plymouth, Wareham, and portions of Carver, Kingston, Middleboro, Rochester, Marion, and Lakeville will receive baits.

Coated Sachet Oral Rabies Vaccine baits will be distributed via Helicopter, Bait Station, and Vehicle.

If you find a vaccine/bait packet:

- · Use a glove or towel to pick it up. Throw it into the woods where children and pets will not find it. If no suitable place is available, dispose of the bait in the
- trash · Wash your hands thoroughly after handling the vaccine/bait package
- · If your pet has eaten or had contact with a bait, it is not harmful to them, but please report the contact to: Barnstable County Department of Health and Environment at (508) 375-6620.
- · If you or another person has had contact with the liquid vaccine, wash the area thoroughly and call the MA Department of Public Health at (617) 983-6800

September 11th Day of Rememberance

Barnstable, MA: The Barnstable Fire Department will again join St Mary's Episcopal Church to put on a special Day of Remembrance on Wednesday, Sept 11 in Barnstable Village. This is the 16th year of the joint recognition that honors and remembers the nearly 3,000 lost on 9/11/01. At 10 AM the Barnstable Fire Department, 3249 Main Street, will hold a ceremony featuring State Rep Kip Diggs as guest speaker. Several members of the community will participate including Suzanne Tongire, as the vocalist. Fire Chief Beal will lead the program. At 10:30 a procession will begin at the fire house and walk up Main Street to St Mary's Episcopal Church. It will be led by Calum MacLachlan and Leslie Kenny on bagpipes and the Barnstable Police Department Honor Guard. The service starts at St Mary's at 10:45 and will feature patriot music and special readings recognizing this solemn day and all those lost and impacted. State Representative and Gold Star Father Steve Xiarhos will be the Keynote speaker. The soloist is Jean Prendergast. The Rev. Dr. Russ Norris will officiate. A reception will follow in St Mary's Old English Gardens.
