





Illegal Dirt Bike Enforcement on Barnstable Public Lands

The use of motorized vehicles on public lands is prohibited in the Town of Barnstable. Barnstable Police and Natural Resource Officers will be patrolling conservation areas and open space land throughout the months of November and December to deter recreational vehicles (dirt bikes and ATVs) from these sensitive habitats and trails. Violators are subject to heavy fines.

The following are some examples of prohibited operation:

- Operating on any Barnstable Public Land designated as open space.
- Operating on public ways or upon or across a controlled access highway.
- Operating on land of another without written permission from the owner.
- Operating in a manner so as to harass or chase wildlife or domestic animals.
- Operating under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

These joint patrols are part of an organized effort to deter operation on public land and educate the public's awareness of the damage these vehicles cause on sensitive habitat.


The Harbormaster's Office would like to remind all boaters:

Unless a vessel owner secures written permission from the Harbormaster staff for a proven need and that the vessel be actively used, no vessel shall be stored or placed on any Town property between November 15 and April 15.





Any vessel placed or remaining between those dates shall be considered abandoned property under this regulation and will be scrapped or otherwise disposed of by the Town. The Town of Barnstable shall not be responsible for damage to or theft of any vessel placed either at this parcel or for loss of property considered abandoned under this regulation.
