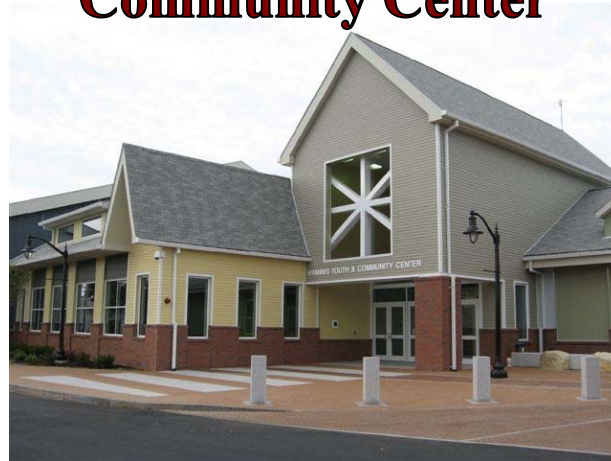
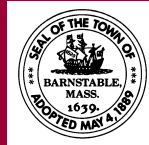

The Hyannis Youth and Community Center, which broke ground on January 18, 2008, is one of the most significant projects undertaken by the Town of Barnstable. The \$24.7 million project is funded by a \$3.5 million grant from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, \$1 million grant from the United States Department of Education, \$1.34 million of private fundraising through the Hyannis Youth and Community Center Foundation, \$1 million of which was donated by the Lyndon P. Lorusso Foundation, and the balance of \$18,863,283 is from Town of Barnstable borrowing authorization and unexpended funds.

Initial funding for the Hyannis Youth and Community Center was voted on in August of 2006. The project was expanded by the Town Council in May 2007 increasing the seating capacity in the Kennedy Rink to 1,500 and 275 seats in the Butler Rink. The Lorusso Foundation Youth Center's gymnasium was also enlarged to accommodate a competition basketball court with two full cross courts and portable seating for spectators along with an elevated three lane jogging track. Additional property was added to the site along Stevens Street to accommodate needed parking and increased building size. The building of 105,000 SF now meets the requests of members of the general public and the Barnstable Youth Commission who spoke favorably on the new proposal.

The Lt. Joseph P. Kennedy Jr. Memorial Skating Rink which served the Town of Barnstable for 52 years was demolished this spring. Center ice of the original Kennedy Skating Rink is marked with a granite marker that was generously donated by John-Lawrence Funeral Home and Maki Monument.

Over the last 50 years, there have been numerous dedicated individuals who have given countless hours to our children and the desire to produce a first class facility such as this. We thank them all for their dedication and commitment to our children and our Town. The Hyannis Youth and Community Center is a fruition of their dreams. We can all take pride in this facility.

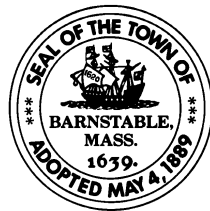
